MTM Online Racing 2010 Cup Series Information

MTM Online Racing is proud to announce the 2010 Cup Series, and its move to the iRacing.com Motorsport Simulations platform. This PDF contains all the information regarding the 2010 series, including event schedule, rules information, and general information.



General Information

The 2010 Cup Series at MTM Online Racing will be a weekly online racing series using iRacing.com's Impala SS Class A "COT" platform. Here is some information about the series:

License Requirements: MTM Online Racing will not require a certain license level to participate. All drivers who hold an iRacing Competition License will be eligible to participate in the series.

Servers and Racing: MTM Online Racing will use iRacing's Hosted Racing feature for the 2010 Cup Series. Passworded servers will be available on the night of the race at 7:30pm Eastern Time. Practice servers may be available during the week and information on those will be posted in the MTM Online Racing forums.

Teamspeak and Communications: All drivers required to have a working copy of Teamspeak 3 installed on their PC, and a headset with working microphone. A driver must be able to communicate with other drivers by using voice chat. All participating drivers are required to be present on the MTM Online Racing Teamspeak 3 Server. Information for the server can be found in the MTM Online Racing forums.

Administrators: All MTM Online Racing Sanctioned events will have at least one administrator present. Administrators are responsible for overseeing the operation of the event sessions, and maintain a fair and competitive environment during the event. Series Registration

Driver Registration: Like previous years, MTM Online Racing will create a forum topic for Driver Registration. All drivers *must* have an active copy of the iRacing Simulation software to register.

Number Assignments: This is the first year that MTM will *not* assign numbers to drivers or allow number reservation. Car numbers will be assigned by the iRacing Hosted Racing server upon connecting to the server. For scoring purposes, drivers will be given the last number they ran with MTM Online Racing, or a random number if they are new to the league.

Custom Paint Skins

Custom Skins: MTM Online Racing will allow the use of custom skins in the 2010 Cup Series events. If a driver wishes to use his or her own skin, it must be approved for use by the MTM Online Racing Administrators. More information can be found in the MTM Online Racing forums.

Series Rules

Rulebook: The series rulebook will be posted on the website. All drivers will be required to read and understand the information in the rulebook.

iRacing Sporting Code: In addition to the MTM Online Racing rulebook, drivers will also be held to the rules stated in the iRacing Sporting Code, available on the iRacing Members Website.

Points System

Points: The 2010 Cup Series will utilize a NASCAR-style points system. Bonus points will be awarded for leading a lap (5 points) and leading the most laps (5 points).

Provisional Points: Drivers will be awarded points for last place in the event of computer troubles or connection issues, provided they were present for the Practice session.
